APRIL 2026 REPORT



Benefits Repayment

During April 2026, collected \$271,457* in benefits repayment. Three individuals were disqualified from SNAP for committing Intentional Program Violations.

For State Fiscal Year 2026, collected \$2,094,328 in benefits repayment to-date.

During April 2026, 43 claims were established worth \$66,929.

Front-End Fraud Work:

- Completed 12 investigations and prevented benefits from being wrongly issued
- State Fiscal Year 2026: Front-End Fraud Investigations completed have a projected savings of \$1,439,724 (includes Medicaid, Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF))



Investigators fielded 85 phone calls in April 2026.

Received 374 referrals during April 2026.

*This amount includes \$162,479.47 collected through the Tax Offset Program during April 2026.
